

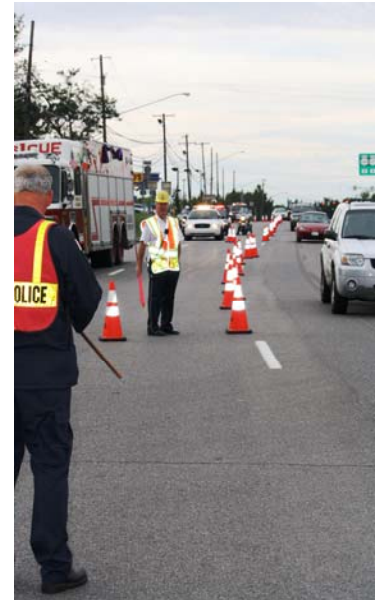


INCIDENT MANAGEMENT IN THE FAST LANE:
